## Rare and exotic regional animals

The Advanced Eco-Accredited Wildlife Habitat is one of only two wildlife sanctuaries in the world that houses the Lumholtz's Tree Kangaroo: one of only two rare species found in Australia and also native to the Tropical North region. The Wildlife Habitat also has 10 species of macropods (wallabies and kangaroos), the most in a walk through environment in Australia, as well as the world's only breeding pair of black necked storks.

## Animal Presentations (On or Off site)

We are also able to offer a wildlife interaction experience so that our guests can really get up close and personal with our animals! Our wildlife keepers can mingle with your guests with pythons, freshwater crocodiles, cockatoos and many other animals, allowing them to touch and hold the animals and learn all about them. Animal presentations are available on or off site.



Our daily animal presentations allow guests to see and touch animals up close, providing a learning experience about Pythons, Koalas and Crocodiles. For a close encounter, you can have the opportunity to purchase a souvenir photo holding these captivating creatures. Presentation times vary and times can be checked daily on entry or at the presentation hut.



## Day Tours

The Wildlife Habitat provides groups with a chance to observe up close a huge range of flora and fauna from The Wet Tropics region. Hand feed kangaroos and wallabies, pat a koala and get up close to crocodiles, cassowaries, tree kangaroos and so much more. Informative guided tours, animal presentations, breakfast, lunch, morning or afternoon tea are available as well as morning or afternoon tea for groups.
