Located at the entrance to Port Douglas, local shuttle buses operate regularly from Port Douglas to our door. If travelling from Cairns, Wildlife Habitat is located 50 minutes north along the scenic "Great Barrier Reef Drive".

Wetlands Habitat

Follow the Stork Walk to see a multitude of bird species foraging in the waterways. The viewing tower provides visitors with a unique opportunity to witness our Black-necked Storks' breeding displays. Within the Wetlands you will also find some of our smaller billabong inhabitants.

Rainforest Habitat

A meandering walkway allows visitors to experience the rainforest. Follow the Cassowary Walk to view local species such as the endangered Southern Cassowary, the Boyd's Forest Dragon, the colourful Eclectus Parrots, and other rainforest species.

Savannah Habitat

On the Wallaby Walk, interact with and hand-feed kangaroos and wallabies. A host of wild native birdlife use the billabong as a sanctuary. View lagoons where both the Estuarine and Freshwater Crocodiles lurk beneath the water or bask on sunlit banks.

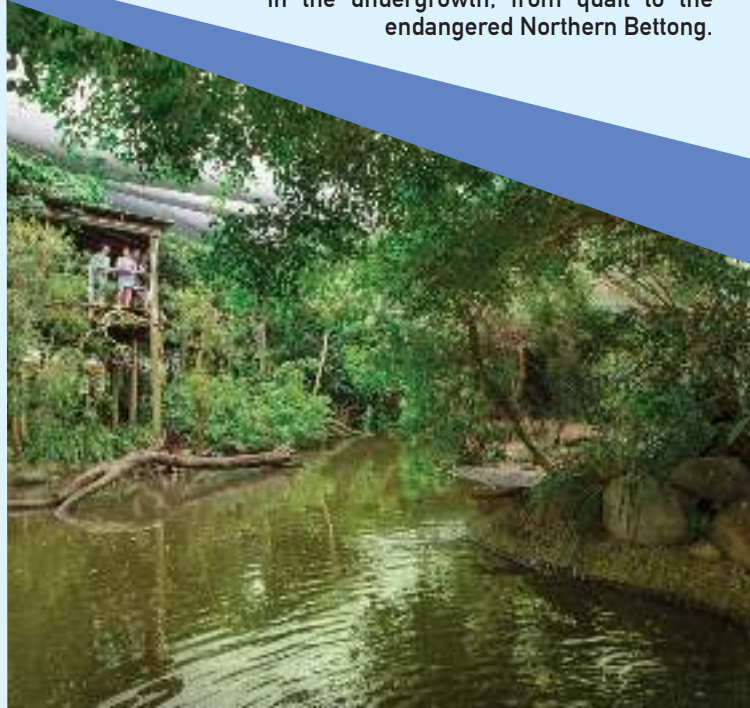
Woodland Habitat

This habitat offers an opportunity to sit amongst the richly coloured birds of northern Australia's open woodlands. Marvel at the complexity of the locally endangered and endemic finches, watch Woodswallows swooping overhead and search for the smallest species that live in the undergrowth, from quail to the endangered Northern Bettong.

THE PARK

The award-winning Wildlife Habitat is Australia's leading environmental wildlife experience, providing visitors with a chance to observe up close a huge range of flora and fauna. Wildlife Habitat was constructed in 1988 on 8 acres of agricultural land that has been transformed to provide a window into our natural environment.

Visitors wander along boardwalks and meandering pathways to experience some of the Wet Tropics endemic species. Allowing for a full immersion opportunity, the park is divided into four distinct environments: Woodlands, Wetlands, Rainforest and Savannah Habitats. Wildlife Habitat is unlike any other zoo or wildlife experience you have encountered.
